**When:** In the first semester, the student, in consultation with the Graduate Advisor, composes the student's Graduate Review Committee and select its chair. Before the 1st Review, the student secures the signatures of faculty who have agreed to serve on the committee and submits the form to the Studio Art Graduate Advisor.

**Who:** A student's MFA Review Committee will have four or five members. The Chair of the Review Committee must be a member of the Studio Art Graduate Studies Committee (GSC). Other committee members will be faculty from Studio Art with up to one of the first four committee members from within the Art and Art History Department but not necessarily from Studio Art. The optional 5th member - selected in the second semester - can be from outside the Studio Art Program and can be from another division in the Art and Art History Department or from another department on campus. In all instances, committee members must be members of the Graduate Studies Committee (GSC) in their college. Optionally, the student can add a committee member who is a UT- affiliated arts professional but not a GSC member. The Graduate Advisor must approve this option.

**Replacements:** A student may nominate a faculty member to replace a chair or committee member on leave or who retires. Additionally, a student may change up to one committee member before the Mid-Program Review. After the Mid-Program Review, the committee is permanent except for the replacement of a chair on leave. When the chair is on leave, the temporary replacement must be one of the other committee members who is also a member of the Studio Art faculty.
